## DRESS CODE

An image of Christian discretion and modesty is to be portrayed. Students who attend official school activities, either on or off campus, must wear clothing that is modest and in good taste. Absolutely **NO hats** in school. School staff may ask a student at anytime to change if they believe a student is dressed inappropriately.

### MALE CLOTHING

**Button up shirts, polo shirts, dress pants, khakis or similar dress pants are appropriate attire.** A collared shirt or button up shirt must be worn daily. Belts must be worn with pants that have belt loops, and pants must be worn at the waistline. **No** Blue jeans, t-shirts, tank tops, snow pants, faddish or extreme-type clothing, sweatshirts/hoodies, will be worn inside at any time, (except school sweatshirts). Shoes must be clean and in good repair, no open toe shoes or outside boots, including snow boots will be worn inside at any time. Clothing should be clean and neat. No necklaces, earrings, or bracelets on male students. Male students must have a standard, conservative haircut, natural hair color only. Hair is to be off the collar and above the ears, with sideburns no longer than the middle of the ears. No extreme haircuts. No facial hair is permitted on students. Hair should be clean and combed. You are our witness at and away from school. Wednesday is Chapel Day! We want to give the Lord our best on Chapel Day! **Ties must be worn every Wednesday for Chapel.**

### Female clothing

**All female students must wear dresses, skirts, or dress pants (loose fitting) with blouses, polo shirts, or sweaters.** Dresses or skirts can be no shorter than the bottom of the knee. Dresses and blouses must not be form fitting (tight) or sleeveless and come to the neckline in front (one inch below the collar bone, two fingers) and back (to the bottom of the neck), without see through material. No slits on skirts or dresses above knees. Females are encouraged to wear tights or pants under dresses or skirts. Slacks must be able to put one fist in pocket, otherwise too tight. **No** blue jeans, snow pants, sweatshirts/hoodies, yoga type pants, sweatpants, t-shirts, tank tops or sleeveless clothing as they do not meet dress code, (except school sweatshirts) . Dress shoes are optional, but shoes must be clean and in good repair, no open toe shoes allowed, (health and safety issues) must have back straps, no snow boots indoors. Female student's hair styles are to be feminine and conservative, no unnatural hair color allowed. Make-up and jewelry should be conservative and minimal, including ear piercing. Wednesday is Chapel day! We want to give the Lord out best on Chapel Day. You are our witness at and away from school. **Dresses or skirts must be worn on Chapel Day.**

### **P.E. Clothes for all students, grades 4-12 includes:**

Black P.E. shorts (knee length, at least). Loose fitting black sweats in cold weather, girls no stretch pants. Red T-shirt, pullover or CRCA P.E. shirt only.  
White socks and tennis shoes (no dirty shoes used outside may be used on the gym floor) .  
Your child's PE clothing will be kept at school and taken home regularly to be washed.

**Grades K-4: Please send a pair of shoes to wear on gym floor only to leave at school.  
PLEASE LABEL ALL CLOTHING INCLUDING SHOES, COATS AND GLOVES.**
